

Vocational Training Team to Ghana- 2022 Disease Prevention and Treatment-Dental

The Vocational Training Team (VTT) is a Rotary Foundation program where teams of Rotarians and non-Rotarians travel overseas with a Rotarian Team Leader to take part in a training project that fits one of the Foundation's Areas of Focus as well as providing the opportunity to engage in their vocation in another part of the world.

Past District Governor Dr. Noel Jackson decided that his area of focus would be "**Disease Prevention and Treatment**" with the focus on dental professional education. The team will travel to the Central Region of Ghana in October of 2022.

WHO CAN PARTICIPATE? We will require a Team Leader and 3-4 Team Members.

Dental health professionals, both Rotarians and non-Rotarians with expertise in: Cosmetic Dentistry, Endodontics, Microbiology, Radiology, Orthodontics are encouraged to apply.

FOCUS OF THE TEAM:

The focus of the Team will be to support identified health priorities and provide training for health professionals in Ghana as well as actual patient treatment to provide modeling of the training skills.

The areas of training will include:

- Cosmetic Dentistry
- Radiology
- Micro-Biology
- Dental Disease Prevention
- Endodontics Orthodontics

QUALIFICATIONS OF VTT MEMBERS:

- Employed in the field of Dentistry with a minimum of 2 years of experience or recently retired.
- Individuals who can work well on a team, are flexible with previous international travel preferred.
- Individuals who can travel to Ghana in October 2022 for two-three weeks.

Travel expenses and accommodations will be provided for the successful applicants.

Prior to departure the VTT will be required to participate in all orientation sessions and complete necessary travel requirements. During the trip, team members must accept the decisions of the Team Leader, travel with the team on the schedules established, maintain standards of behavior that will reflect positively on Rotary, and share their expertise and skills with the host country participants. After the trip, the VTT must prepare and submit final reports, and speak about the experience to Rotary Clubs and other groups.
