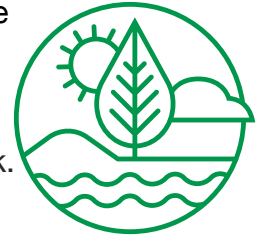


# DISTRICT 6400 CONFERENCE SERVICE PROJECT

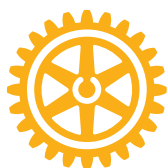
### GROUP 2: 1pm-3pm
